



## Swimming at Hamsey Green 2018-9

Swimming and water safety is an extremely important part of the PE curriculum at Hamsey Green Primary and another way of helping children to lead healthy and active lives.

Year 5 attend swimming lessons at Warlingham Swimming Pool weekly during the Spring Term. For those children in Year 5 who are not able to swim at least 25 metres, they attend 'top-up' swimming lessons in Year 6 on top of normal swimming sessions.

Year 6 Pupils were prioritised this year due to the adverse weather conditions and the sudden closure of the swimming pool.

Pupils are grouped according to their ability and are taught to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
