



## Swimming at Hamsey Green 2017/8

Swimming and water safety is an extremely important part of the PE curriculum at Hamsey Green Primary and another way of helping children to lead healthy and active lives.

Year 5 attended swimming lessons at Warlingham Swimming Pool every other week during the Spring Term, however, due to adverse weather conditions and the closure of the pool suddenly, pupils were unable to swim.

This cohort of children, now in Year 6, will be prioritised to swim at least 25 metres and attend 'top-up' swimming lessons in the summer term in Year 6.

Pupils are grouped according to their ability and are taught to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
  - And perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
